- History of modifications, reverting revisions
- Differences between revisions
- Per-type policies, per-type semantics
- Replaceable backend (SVN?)

#2

In-place Staging

(Kapil)

- Lets you work on one piece of content while another is “live”
- Built on top of CMFEditions
- Simple UI!

#3

Locking

(Raphael, Jean-François, Limi)

- Uses WebDAV semantics
- “Stealable” locks
- Locks are automatic on any edit action
- Tells you who locked it, and how long ago

- Infrastructure to write advanced portlets

(Wichert)

- Decentralized login/identity system
- Lets you use your URL as a login
- In use by sites like LiveJournal, Technorati
- Plugins exist for Wordpress, MediaWiki, etc
- Backed by companies like Verisign
- Available today and shipping with Plone 3
