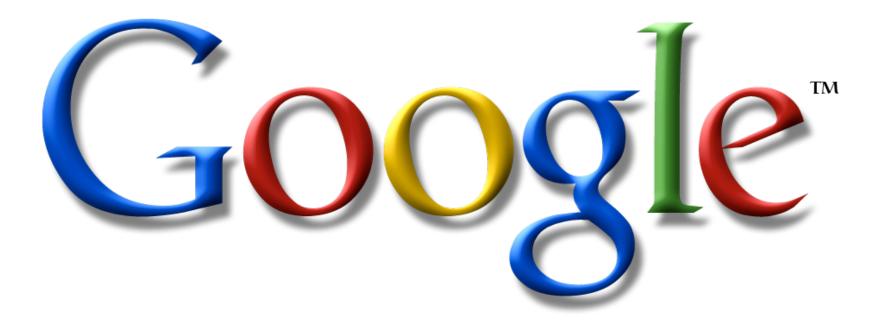

### In-place Staging (Kapil)

- Lets you work on one piece of content while another is "live"
- Built on top of CMFEditions
- Simple UI!



### Locking (Raphael, Jean-François, Limi)

- Uses WebDAV semantics
- "Stealable" locks
- Locks are automatic on any edit action
- Tells you who locked it, and how long ago




