- 501(c)(3) Tax Exempt
- Trademark protection (plone.eu, Plone®)
- Third year of operation
- Functional and working!
- 2007 board elected during this conference

# Python

- Established technology
- Mozilla has Python in trunk
- OpenOffice UNO bindings
- Google, Ubuntu
- Massive amounts of traction
- Plone is Python's biggest CMS by far

# Markets

- NGOs (Oxfam, Nature Conservancy)
- Corporate (Disney, eBay, BMC)
- Education (UC Berkeley, Columbia, Rice)
- Government (Hawai'i, Texas, local governments)

- Major integration products:
  - Salesforce
  - Democracy in Action
  - GetActive

# Growing pains

- Plone is growing at a phenomenal rate
- Challenge: Mailing lists only scale so far, and we have hit that ceiling (~60 posts/day)
- List traffic is constant at this point, even though Plone has grown a lot
- Holy grail: Message board interface on mailing lists

# plone.org

- New server at osuosl.org
- Moving SVN and mailing lists
- Sustain much more traffic
- SVN/Apache is biggest load



# Plone is 5!

- Plone turns 5 years old (October 2006)
- Mature, stable, has traction
- Plone is a standard
- Feature set that rivals commercial systems
- People are betting their businesses on Plone

- Excellent R&D platform
- Plone 3.0: All new components are written using Zope 3
- Goal: Plone 3.5 move the remaining infrastructure over

# Plone 3.0

- Versioning + Staging
- Portlet engine
- Rules engine
- OpenID
- See separate talk for overview
- Release: Q1 2007

# Plone 3.5

- Still on the idea stage:
  - Improved member handling
  - Improved media handling
  - Improved Document Management capabilities (BLOB support)
  - Better dependency handling, installation (eggs)
  - More flexible theming approach
  - Separate content production and delivery
