# **Conference vision and goals**

Holding the next Plone Conference in Paris will be an important occasion for French "plonistas" to meet, discuss and compare their experiences.

Furthermore, the choice of one of the most famous and easily reachable capitals in the world can attract many new friends (*companies, developers, consultants, users*); this will allow to spread Plone and the open source technology widely in France and Europe.

The main purposes and objectives of the Paris Conference are:

- Promoting the use of Plone as the most flexible, usable, fast and secure open-source CMS.
- Spreading the basic knowledge of Plone technology through an involving "open training" event (more details below).
- Evaluating the state of Three D's (Dexterity, Diazo and Deco), and exploring their future perspectives together with the \*new\* Plone Experience they provide.
- Keeping the costs of the event affordable for every budget, allowing the highest number of interested people to attend.

#### **Conference dates**

November 5 - 6: Training days, with standard and "Open Training" sessions

November 7 - 8 - 9: Conference

November 10 - 11: Sprint days

On November 5th and 6th, in addition to the standard training sessions, we are programming an **Open Training** for all those *new to Plone*. This training is intended for the acquisition of





the basic *know-how* in the use of Plone: a "free entrance" open space where experts and newbies come together to deepen into standard Plone features, a sort of live "hands on" user's mailing list! We would love to attract new users and developers making them understand why Plone is different, and we think that an "open" mode could be useful in this sense.

During the actual conference days, **selected speakers** will vitalize a rich program with talks about Plone and its ecosystem, live tutorials on technology, sessions with cases about a successful use of Plone. Of course, we will continue the positive tradition of *Lightning Talks* at the end of each day and *Open Spaces* during the last day of the conference!

The Conference week will end with the usual sprint days, to make people work together to improve Plone more and more!


All the conference programme will be recorded and published online to spread all the materials as soon as possible after the Conference days.

#### **Conference Venue**

The Conference will take place at the MAS, a modern, comfortable and functional structure located in the south-west of the city, easily reachable with the metro (line 7 stop Porte d'Ivry; line 14 stop Olympiades), RER (line C stop Bibliothèque F.Mitterrand) and street car (line 3 stop Porte d'Ivry).











The MAS is a perfect location for the conference: it has a very large hall with 250 seats (the "Salle Emile Laffon") completely equipped with everything you need for the success of crowded general meetings, and other six smaller rooms with all comforts.
